New Engineering Students Attend 5-Day Induction PDH Conducts Tagseer **Programs**

Students who progressed from the School of Foundation Studies attended a 5-day induction program at the Assembly Hall from 12th to 16th February 2023. The induction programme this time was of a different taste. Each day was packed with activities and tasks which students had to participate and do. An activity passport was given to them to track and monitor their performance and participation. Different speakers came to induct the students on the key services and programs available to them during their stay in the college. Prof. Ahmed Hassan Al Balushi, Dean CoE, welcomed the new entrants. He emphasized on the importance of proper study habits while optimizing the involvement in various clubs that help them be competent and well-rounded engineers. Successful completers received a certificate of completion.

Moreover, department-specific inductions for CEE, ECE, and MIE Departments took place on day 2 of the induction week. This was intended to orient students to the specificities of their respective departments in terms of department organization, program and course requirements, policies and procedures, and student professional memberships. This MOHERI-required induction intends to brief and induct new students to various college-related services and activities which enables them to have a comfortable and conducive learning environment while journeying to obtain a BEng degree from NU soon.

PDH Develops New Students' Companies

The Department of Professional Development and Humanities developed two students' companies in the current academic year, 2022/2023. Tala Students' Company targetted the agricultural sector by creating an Omani product of environmental bags that protect the dates from its palm trees from humidity, rains, and insects before harvesting. This bag was tested in laboratories to confirm its efficiency in protecting the dates. The product is ideal for farmers, agricultural companies and government organizations that support the agriculture sector.

Skydrop Students' Company has manufactured an innovative device that converts humid air into fresh water for drinking. This device aims to solve problems faced by adventurers, backpackers, boat fishermen and tourism agencies. This device can effectively provide clean water in all circumstances.



In collaboration with Ministry of Labor, the College of Engineering conducted the Tagseer Program for the college graduates in two sessions between 20th to 24th November 2022 and 18th to 22nd December 2022.



The program develops employability skills of participants and supports them during the job application process. The Tagseer Program helps participants construct a professional CV, prepare for job interviews by responding to commonly asked questions. In addition, graduates are trained on effective communication skills and assisted with creating a LinkedIn profile. The participants provided very positive feedback on the program benefits and will be conducted soon for the third batch.

CEE Conducts Workshop on Renewable Energy Resource for Oman

The Civil and Environmental Engineering Department conducted a one-day workshop on 4th January 2023 at the College of Engineering. The workshop aimed to share the research project findings on the use of Wadi Daygah Dam as a mega battery and a renewable energy resource for Oman. The workshop was attended by various groups of experts and professionals from the Ministry of Agriculture, Fishery and Water Resources, Public Authority of Water, and Oman Power and Water Procurement, Oman Water Society, Sultan Qaboos University, consulting engineers, and staff members of NU. Dr Akbar Karimi (NU) and Dr M. R. Nikoo (SOU) facilitated three sessions that covered topics on water resources management, simulation modelling and optimization modelling.

MIE, PDH Conduct Workshop on Entrepreneurship Theory and Application

The MIE and PDH Department conducted a student workshop on "Entrepreneurship Theory and Application" on 21st March 2023 at the College of Engineering Conference Hall from 9.30am to 12nn.

The student workshop provided undergraduate engineering students the opportunity to be familiarized with the application of entrepreneurship knowledge to Level 4 students' final projects with the integration of UN Sustainable Development Goals and Oman Vision 2040. A total of 51 students across different engineering programs of the National University have participated in this workshop including members of the Entrepreneurs and Innovators' Club. The workshop focused on translating basic entrepreneurship and innovation skills into entrepreneurship and SME development visualization which builds on business ideas. The workshop was facilitated by Dr Kabaly Pitchakannu Subramanian of the Arab Open University in Muscat, Oman.

NU College of Engineering and Shiraz University of Technology Organize International Symposium



Prof. Mohammad Al-Shafaee, Dean of the college told the guests: "This new COMHS students' girls' hostel is equipped with comfortable suites with single bedroom, modern kitchen and laundry facilities, and state of the art gym for girls. This project is also characterized by its green surroundings and outdoor sports fields for practising sports activities. The new COMHS students hostel suites project consists of 3 buildings, each building has 4 floors, and 150 rooms equipped with all services as well as living rooms, study and deliberation rooms, and various activities.

During her visit, she addressed the faculty members, staff and the students and praised the hard work the faculty members and staff have put into this college. H. E. the Minister and the accompanying delegation were briefed on the college's facilities, laboratories, and simulator building. H. E. the Minister and the delegation visited the Gross Anatomy lab, Physiology lab, and the library. She stressed the need to link the College's programs to the most seen clinical cases in Oman.

H. E. urged private higher education institutions to convert their campuses into green buildings using renewable and sustainable energy.

Faculty development workshop on program evaluation and quality management by Prof. Janet Grant

The The Medical Education Unit (MEU) and the core group for Research in Medical Education (RIME), COMHS, NU organized a faculty development workshop on "program evaluation and quality management" by Professor Janet Grant, Director, Cenmedic, United Kingdom and Honorary Professor at the University College London Medical School. Prof. Janet is also a Senior Scholar, University of Illinois at Chicago College

of Medicine and Chair of standards updating for the World Federation for Medical Education (WFME). The event was organized on Tuesday, February 21st at the Al Bathinah Hall, Second Floor, COMHS, Sohar Campus. The workshop delineated the issues, methods and frameworks which enabled participants to think about, analyses, and plan their own program evaluation for quality management and improvement at their institutions. 
National Vision 2040

Workshop on Condition Monitoring of Rotating Machines

Under the patronage of Professor Ahmed AL Balushi, the Dean College of Engineering at the National University of Science and Technology, a workshop on condition monitoring of rotating machines was hosted for the students and recent graduates of the College of Engineering.

Prof. Ahmed Al Balushi Dean at the College of Engineering at NU has inaugurated this workshop at Caledonian Campus on 10th May 2023. The workshop was facilitated by the research team of the CoERG project titled "Intelligent Prediction and Fault Diagnosis System for Belt Drive" (CoERG21.1), funded by NU, Oman and the research group "Intelligent Maintenance Monitoring & Instrumentation". This workshop aims to create awareness about the condition monitoring of rotating machines and provide hands-on training on the Machine Fault Simulator and the Centrifugal Fan Belt drive experimental setup for the various mechanical fault analysis. The participants are also trained to acquire vibration signals using LabVIEW software along with NI Data Acquisition System (DAQ).

Professor K P Ramachandran, acting Dean of Deanship Graduate Studies of Research, emphasized state-of-the-art trends and application of condition monitoring and highlighted the current research activities of the research group. In his keynote address, Dr. Mohammed Al Yahyai, Senior Rotating Equipment Engineer, Petroleum Development of Oman (PDO), highlighted the importance and application of condition monitoring in PDO. The workshop covered mostly hands-on training and activities. Participants consisted of candidates from continuing students and recent graduates of the College of Engineering. Twenty-five participants benefited from this workshop and participated in real-time data acquisition system.


