The team achieved remarkable success by securing 1st place in the inter-collegiate AI Project competition at the Science Fair, under the patronage of the Deputy Vice-Chancellor & Provost, Dr. Salim AI Araimi. This achievement is a testament to the exceptional talents, hard work, and dedication exhibited by the college's outstanding staff and students and their commitment played a pivotal role in clinching the top position, showcasing the college's high standard.

experience for the hospitalized children.



Basic First Aid and Sport Injuries Workshop:

The College of Medicine and Health Sciences represented by the Community Engagement Office organized a workshop on Basic First Aid and Sport Injuries for Sports Aiders from Sports Teams - Suhar Sport Club on 19th October for two days, at the college of Medicine Health Sciences campus. The workshop was conducted by Mr Hamed Al Hamdi & Mr Khamis Al Aoufi, Skill Lab supervisors at COMHS. They gave a theory lecture and showed some videos to the candidates. They also conducted practical training on Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and automated external defibrillator (AED) for each candidate. On the second day, the trainers addressed common sports injuries including sprains, strains, contusions, fractures, dislocations, overuse injury, and skin injuries.

Upon conclusion, Mr Said Al Kindi, Community Engagement Manager, presented certificates to both the participants and trainers, acknowledging their active participation and commitment to enhancing their first aid and sports injury management skills.



The Little Paramedic Event:

The College of Medicine and Health Sciences successfully conducted a workshop titled "The Little Paramedic" on 3rd December for over four days, at the Suhar Club Hall, catering to students from two government schools.

The primary objective of the workshop was to empower the younger generation with basic paramedic skills, enabling them to handle emergency situations effectively. Participants were

trained on essential first aid principles and safety protocols applicable to diverse environments. The focus was on equipping them with the knowledge and skills required to respond promptly and efficiently in situations demanding immediate action to save lives.

Key workshop topics included techniques for managing incidents such as swallowing the tongue, addressing nosebleeds, and treating wounds resulting from accidents. Through engaging sessions, the students gained practical insights into these critical areas, fostering a sense of responsibility and preparedness in dealing with unforeseen emergencies.









Site Visit to COMHS by TEPDAD for WFME Accreditation of its Medical Program:

The recent site visit for program accreditation was conducted by the Association for Evaluation and Accreditation of Medical Education Programs (TEPDAD) from 5th to 8th November 2023, which marked a significant milestone for COMHS. The site visit team had the following members: Prof. Iskender Sayek (Chair), Mustafa Kemal Alimoğlu, Professor of Medical Education, Akdeniz University Medical School, Ali Kağan Coşkun, Professor of Surgery, University Gülhane Medical School and Levent Altıntaş, Associate Professor of Medical Education, Acibadem University Medical School. Ms Khadija Al Balushi from the Oman Authority for Academic Accreditation and Quality Assurance of Education was also present in the team.

The site-visit was conducted to evaluate the status of the medical school against 9 standards as stipulated by the WFME global standards (2015). The events related to the site visit commenced with the Dean's presentation which highlighted COMHS'fulfillment of WFME standards at various levels. This was



followed by a meeting with the Education Committee members which deliberated on aspects related to curriculum delivery, curricular integration, educational innovations, assessment strategies/approaches and feedback mechanisms. Meeting with staff related to student affairs, community engagement, wellbeing, admission and registration were organized thereafter. This was followed by the visit of the accreditation team to the educational facilities including classrooms, laboratories, library & IT resources, hostel and recreational facilities. A meeting with the administrative heads from NU, including the Vice Chancellor and the Deputy Vice Chancellor followed.

The team also had meetings with Directors and affiliate faculty from Sohar Regional Hospital and Rustaq hospital; the clinical training sites of COMHS. Interactions with Heads of departments and alumni were also a part of the site visit. A representative from our academic partner, University of West Virginia, USA, Prof. Christopher J Martin, was also available to discuss academic collaboration related matters.

The detailed examination on all days, encompassed every aspect of our site's operations, including infrastructure, curriculum, teaching-learning, assessment, faculty qualifications, hospital facilities, student facilities, wellbeing, governance and program evaluation.



COMHS Organizes Climate Awareness Programs:

Emphasizing the commitment of NU in promoting climate action and sustainability, the Medical Education Unit (MEU) of COMHS organized a one-day awareness program combining education, advocacy, and community engagement to address the issue of climate change. The event was organized in collaboration with Oman's Environment Authority, Environment Society of Oman, Students for Climate Action (under the aegis of Activities and Initiatives subcommittee), and the Department of Student Affairs, COMHS.

Prof. Mohammed Al Shafaee, Dean of COMHS welcomed the guests and participants. He stressed upon the significance of such events as a part of social accountability. The daylong event commenced in the morning with an exhibition that featured displays showcasing sustainable technologies, eco-friendly products, and successful climate change mitigation initiatives by the Environment Authority of Oman. Posters that focus on iconic visuals explaining the wider realities of climate change and its impact on health displayed by the MEU were a hallmark of this exhibition. A student booth, run by the medical students aimed at raising awareness and inspiring positive actions,

received appreciation from the visitors. Attendees also had the opportunity to explore practical solutions and engage with experts to better understand the impact of their daily choices on the environment specifically on themes related to renewable energy and waste reduction.

The highlight of the afternoon session was an inspiring talk by Ms. Rumaitha Al Busaidi, Director, of the Environment Society of Oman, a renowned advocate for climate action, sharing her experiences being a climate activist in the region. She shared her insights into the current state of the planet, emphasizing the urgency of taking immediate action to mitigate climate change. She encouraged the audience to become actively involved in sustainable practices and to advocate for policy changes that prioritize the environment. This was followed by a productive interaction of students, faculty, and staff with Ms Rumaitha on issues related to pollution, environmental sustainability, sustainable development, global warming, and impact on human health. Prof. Ciraj Ali Mohammed, Head of MEU specified that COMHS had initiated steps to include climate-related topics in the medical and lab sciences curriculum and possibilities of collaborative research in this domain are also being explored.

Ms. Yumna Al Khaduri, Director, of Activities and Initiatives from the COMHS Students Advisory Council, proposed the vote of thanks.



White Coat and Medical Oath Ceremony:

The College of Medicine and Health Sciences, NU, organized the White Coat and Medical Oath Ceremony on Wednesday, December 20, 2023, for 166 medical students under the patronage of H.E. Dr. Said bin Harib Al Lamki. Undersecretary of the Ministry of Health for Health Affairs. The main aim of the ceremony was to place the white coat on the shoulders of future doctors as they move to the hospital for clinical training.

Prof. Mohammad Ali Al-Shafee, Dean of the College of Medicine and Health Sciences, stated that the White Coat ceremony is a global tradition that symbolizes the beginning of clinical training. He congratulated the 166 future doctors pointing out the importance of their training during this stage in tenets of leadership, ethics, human values, communication skills, and care for patients that will qualify them to be distinguished physicians in their chosen fields.

The Keynote Speaker for the ceremony was Prof. Lamk Al Lamki, an esteemed figure in Radiology and medical education in Oman, who delivered an insightful keynote address, adding depth to the ceremony.

H.E. Dr. Said bin Harib Al Lamki, the patron of the ceremony, honored the best MOH clinical faculty with awards who collaborated and assisted in the clinical training of the students. Top achievers from MD1 to MD4 classes were also rewarded with certificates. The MD4 students were honored on the stage with white coats on their shoulders by the assistant deans and senior clinical faculty members. This was followed by a recitation of the Hippocratic Medical Oath and singing of an operetta. At the end, a group photograph was taken with the chief guests and the faculty members. This occasion was attended by the parents and other family members of the MD4 students, with lots of joy and presenting of flower bouquets to their sons and daughters; the future doctors of Oman.

Community Awareness Campaigns by COMHS Students:

Under the Department of Epidemiology & Public Health, community health, students of MD4 class organized a HIV/ AIDS awareness campaign on 7th December 2023 in Sohar park from 5pm to 9pm. Health education material provided an insight into HIV/AIDS in Oman, modes of transmission, clinical features, diagnosis, treatment, myths about HIV AIDS, legal concerns about HIV AIDS and laws pertaining to it specifically in Oman. An Instagram account was created with over 400 followers in which videos and posts about the event (time and venue), target audience (teenagers and adults) and the aim (to create awareness about the disease and overcoming the stigma that comes with the disease and how to provide support) were uploaded. Interactive posts in the account were uploaded in which questions were posted for the followers to answer.



World Diabetes Day at Oasis Mall, Sohar:

A Diabetes Awareness Campaign was held in the evening of 16 November 2023 in solidarity with World Diabetes Day, at Oasis Mall. The purpose of this event was to provide awareness to the public about diabetes in Oman, diagnosis and management of diabetes, prevention and control of diabetes including healthy food alternatives, causes, risk factors and complications of diabetes. 
A Field Trip at the Pharmaceutical Company
