

COMHS Curriculum Retreat - 2024:

The curriculum and learning resources committee (CLRC) at COMHS organised the curriculum retreat of 2024 focusing on the theme "Review, Refine and Reform" on 03rd July at Radisson Blu International, Sohar. The retreat was designed to appraise existing curricular activities and share recommendations that originated from End of the Year (EOY) reports pertinent to curriculum governance and delivery. The deliberations were also intended to review the results of benchmarking exercises that were carried out in the areas of curricular integration, clinical teaching and research in the UG curriculum. The retreat also reflected on the TEPDAD recommendations and discussed preliminary action plans as a response to this report. Besides faculty and student representatives from COMHS, invited participants included, members from the college administration and College Board, members from alumni and industry along with faculty from affiliated hospitals.



Dean COMHS, Prof. Mohammed Al Shafaee invited at Sohar University:

On February 1, 2024, Sohar University hosted a pivotal meeting with H.E. Prof. Dr. Rahma Bint Ibrahim Al Mahrouqi, Minister of Higher Education, Research, and Innovation (MOHERI), along with the Governor of North Al-Batinah and key representatives from the Ministry, the Municipal Council, and various government institutions in the North Al-Batinah Governorate.

During the meeting, Prof. Mohammed Al Shafaee, Dean of the College of Medicine, presented an in-depth overview of key development projects. His presentation highlighted the College's mission, vision, facilities, research initiatives, educational advancements, and community engagement efforts, earning commendations from the Minister and other local governance officials. The meeting served as a valuable networking platform and laid the foundation for future collaborations aimed at addressing community needs.



COMHS represents Oman at the WFME International Symposium on "Good Practices in Undergraduate Medical Education":

COMHS was invited to participate in the "World Federation for Medical Education Good Practices Symposium on UndergraduateMedical Education 2024" which was held in Istanbul from 22nd to 24th May 2024, organised by the Association for Evaluation and Accreditation of Medical Education Programs. The symposium was designed to foster regional and global dialogue on enhancing the quality of undergraduate medical education to meet the evolving needs of society and the healthcare system, with a focus on accreditation and educational best practices. The Dean of COMHS, Prof. Mohammed Al Shafaee presented our experiences on "HOT-Cases for Curricular Integration during Clinical Clerkships" explaining the innovative approaches adopted for vertical integration during clinical years. Prof. Ciraj Ali Mohammed, Head of Medical Education shared the best practices on pioneering Interprofessional Education initiatives in the region aimed at fostering collaborative practice among students from different healthcare professions.



College Open Day 2024 (Festival Village):

COMHS organized the College Open Day on Tuesday, February 27, 2024. The event, themed "Festival Village," was held under the auspices of the College Dean, Prof. Mohamed Al Shafaee. The event was sponsored by MG Motor Middle East Company, Sohar Hospital Blood Donation Centre, the Fine Arts Studio at the Directorate General of Culture, Sports, and Youth of the Ministry of Culture, Sports, and Youth, and Al Batinah North Municipality. There were cultural display tents representing eleven countries: Oman, Bahrain, Palestine, India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Nigeria, Sudan, Iraq, Lebanon, and Egypt. Students from these countries set up their own tents, showcasing various ancient arts and crafts, traditional apparel and fashion, and different traditional industries such as textiles, silver, and wooden trades. Additionally, local entrepreneurs and traders displayed their products for sale and participation.

In the evening, a fashion show was organized accompanied by a music band performance. Finally, Ms. Maryam Al Zadjali announced the winners of the first- and second-best student paintings and digital designs competition and the four best cultural tents competition. The winners were Ms. Bashair Yaqoob and Mr. Mohammed Al Rawi, were awarded cash prizes by Prof. Mohamed Al Shafaee. The winners for the best cultural tents competition were as follows: first prize went to the Iraq tent led by Maryam Ahmed, second prize to the Palestine tent led by Ms. Muntaha Al Manji, and third and fourth prizes to the Oman tent led by Ms. Asma Al Mashaikhi and the Bahrain tent led by Ms. Al Yamama Al Nasri.

National University congratulates Ms. Zainab Khadim Jaffer, final year MD student from COMHS for being a member of the winning team at the international interprofessional case competition (I2C2-2024). I2C2 provides avenues to collaborate on a small team with learners across professions, institutions, and countries from October 8th 2023 to 25th February 2025. As the competition evolves, the teams gain valuable interprofessional experience resolving a complex clinical case with their team. The competition culminates in developing a video that shares the creative solutions which the team uses in dealing with this complex case. Top-scoring teams presented their solution in a live final competition round to a panel of judges who rated their performance and innovative solutions focusing on contributions made towards outstanding interprofessional collaboration Ms. Zainab expressed her satisfaction having worked with a team of students from diverse professions and regions and acquiring the necessary knowledge and attitudes for collaborative, patient-centered practice. She thanked the IPE subcommittee of COMHS for promoting such activities among students of National University..

International Symposium on One Health (ISOH) - 2024:

The international symposium on one health was hosted by the Medical Education Unit, COMHS in collaboration with experts from WHO-EMRO, WHO-SEARO, EMPHNET, and Office of Health Affairs, Ministry of Health, Oman on 23rd February 2024. The event organized under NU lecture series provided a unique opportunity to engage in meaningful conversations to explore the interconnectedness of human, animal, and environmental health with specific reference to the MENA region. This initiative provided a platform for networking among professionals, researchers, policymakers, and organizations working in this domain. In his inaugural address Dr. Ali Al Bimani stated that by organizing this event National University has demonstrated its dedication and commitment in finding innovative solutions





to the most pressing global health challenges. The ISOH-2024 registered over 235 participants from 27 countries which included health care professionals, public health practitioners, veterinarians and agricultural/environmental scientists, Faculty/ Staff, students and researchers from health professions. Representatives from NGOs and Industry working in the areas related to one health were also present.



Faculty Development Programme on "Competencies for Medical Educators in the Era of artificial intelligence":

The Medical Education unit of COMHS organised an online workshop on 28th May 2024 on "Competencies for Medical Educators in the Era of Artificial Intelligence (AI)" which was facilitated by Prof. Mohammed Hassanien, Head of Assessment Unit and AI Committee, King Abdulaziz University, Saudi Arabia. The evolving landscape of medical education and the healthcare industry, emphasizing the increasing role of AI was highlighted.

The benefits of AI in enhancing educational outcomes, personalizing learning, and improving clinical decision-making was also discussed. The session also addressed the necessity for medical educators to stay current with technological advancements to prepare students for a future integrated with

Interprofessional Colloquium – 2024:

An interprofessional online colloquium for MD students from clinical years along with students from other health professions including nursing and lab sciences was organised on 15th May 2024. The colloquium had two major themes one on interprofessional identity conducted by Dr. Jan Jaap Reinders, University Medical Center Groningen, Netherland and the second one on interprofessional collaboration delivered by Prof. John Gilbert University of British Columbia, Canada. The sessions were designed to instil the values of interprofessional collaboration and patient centred care.



COMHS Walkathon:

Under the patronage of Dr. Ali Al Bimani, Vice-Chancellor of the National University, the inaugural CoMHS Walkathon took place on February 5th, promoting healthier lifestyles and raising awareness about the prevention of metabolic syndrome. Participants from educational institutions, industries, and the University's own students, faculty, and staff came together in a shared commitment to wellness. The event featured health awareness stations, invigorating exercises, and refreshments, supported by the Royal Oman Police and medical teams. The day concluded with sponsor recognition and giveaways, highlighting the university's dedication to fostering community and health.



IFMSA General Assembly: Eastern Mediterranean Regional Meeting "EMR20":

The students of COMHS participated in the 20th Eastern Mediterranean Regional Meeting (EMR20) held in Amman, Jordan, an event that gathered 250 medical students from 16 countries. The meeting held on 4-12 February 2024, focused on enhancing healthcare leadership skills through diverse sessions on public health, human rights, and medical education. Our delegation of 23 students engaged in pre-EMR capacity-building sessions, and actively participated in workshops and cultural exchanges during the main event. Highlights included a national food party featuring Omani cuisine and a well-organized social program exploring Amman's historic sites.



Fostering Social Accountability through Dialogues:

The COMHS conducted a session on "Fostering Social Accountability through Dialogues" on 18th February 2024. Dr. Mohamed H. Taha from the Medical Education Centre at University of Sharjah and Prof. Ciraj Ali Mohammed from the Medical Education Unit at COMHS were the facilitators. The event aimed to explore ways to extend medical education to the community, forge partnerships bridging academic knowledge and community health needs, and develop socially responsible healthcare professionals. This participatory session included students, alumni, faculty, and 20 external members from the community and healthcare industry. Dean Prof. Mohammed Shafaee emphasized that the session's goals were to create

meaningful partnerships to address community health needs effectively.



Blood Donation Campaign:



On 27th February 2024, COMHS in collaboration with the Ministry of Health (Sohar Hospital Blood Bank), organized a successful Blood Donation Campaign held at the College's Skill Lab. The campaign aimed to raise awareness about the importance of blood donation and address the blood supply shortage at Sohar Hospital. The event saw an impressive turnout of 70 donors, greatly appreciated by the Department of Blood Bank Services. The campaign highlighted the effective collaboration between the College of Medicine, the Community Engagement Office, and the Sohar Hospital Blood Bank Team, underscoring our commitment to community service and critical healthcare needs.

Premarital Testing Awareness Campaign at Muscat Grand Mall:

On April 26th, 2024, COMHS represented by the Community Engagement Office and MD5 students, hosted a Premarital Testing Awareness Campaign at Muscat Grand Mall. Partnering with the National Genetic Centre, the campaign aimed to educate the public about genetic disorders and the critical importance of premarital testing. The event featured a variety of engaging activities, including expert-led discussions on genetics and hereditary conditions, as well as personalized counselling services. MD5 students played a key role, delivering interactive presentations and case studies that underscored the value of proactive health measures. With 16 dedicated student organizers and a turnout of 240 participants, the campaign effectively raised community awareness and encouraged informed decision-making, reflecting the College's ongoing commitment to service and community engagement.



IP Poster Day: Enhancing Health outcomes through Interprofessional Education (IPE):

The Interprofessional Poster Competition, which was organised on 30th April 2024, showcased a vibrant exchange of ideas, featuring 16 posters that highlighted the diverse competencies of interprofessional education and practice. The event held for MD4 students in the Students Hub of COMHS aimed to promote collaborative learning and practice among different health professions, emphasizing the significance of interprofessional competencies in improving patient care. Participants expressed their satisfaction of understanding how interprofessional education can be leveraged to improve teamwork, communication, and ultimately, patient care.

This certification meets the ASHRAE (Energy Audits) Standard 211 requirements to be a Qualified Energy Auditor.

Industrial visits:

On March 11th, a group of twenty Marine Engineering Year 1 students, accompanied by their supervisor Eng Nauryzbek, had the opportunity to visit the Abaq Al Ebdaa Yacht Construction Site in Suwaiq City. The purpose of the visit was to gain practical insight into the process of yacht and boat construction using fibre-reinforced plastic (FRP).

At the construction site, we were warmly welcomed by Engineer Suleiman, the owner of the company, and Senior Engineer Jino. They provided us with a comprehensive overview of the yachtbuilding process, focusing particularly on the vacuum infusion process (VIP) technique for laminating and creating the hull of the boat. It is worth mentioning that the Abaq Al Ebdaa company is the only one in Oman which is using this technology.

During the demonstration, we observed the intricate steps involved in the VIP technique, including coating by gelcoat, strengthening the mold and hull with high-density foam, and preparing the mold using CNC machines. Engineer Suleiman and Senior Engineer Jino patiently explained each stage, allowing us to understand the complexities and precision required in yacht construction.

Research Development Program | 4th, 5th & 6th, March 2024.


